Deadline for receipt of materials is the 20th, two months before the issue month (e.g. deadline for the May issue would be March 20). Earlier deadlines apply for January show products, which need to be turned in by approximately early October.

To have a meeting, show, conference, convention or exposition considered for inclusion in the magazine, please send a release that includes:

1. The name, place and time of the event.

2. A source for obtaining further information, including the name of the individual and/or organization to contact, phone and fax numbers, e-mail address and web address, if applicable.

Please send notices as far in advance as possible. Note that for events held abroad, our list starts six months after the date of the issue. For example, our January issue would feature information about events outside of North America from the following June forward.

Due to space restrictions, not all events can be listed in our Meetings and Shows section. A more comprehensive list of events can be found on our Industry Calendar on our web site (www.ashrae. org).
