I don't know which listing to use in <u>ASHRAE Standard 62.1-20</u> Question 1 for a space in the building that I am designing. Can ASHRAE which listing to use?		
Answer	ASHRAE does not define the characteristics of the space types listed in Table 6-1 of ASHRAE Standard 62.1-2016, "Ventilation for Acceptable Indoor Air Quality" leaving that to the judgment of the practitioner and/or authority having enforcement jurisdiction. However, if there is an ambiguity in the standard that makes judgment difficult, you can get an official interpretation from the committee.
