Answer The National Climatic Data Center ([NCDC - www.ncdc.noaa.gov](http://www.ncdc.noaa.gov)) Climate at a Glance web site ([www.ncdc.noaa.gov/climate-information/climate-us](http://www.ncdc.noaa.gov/climate-information/climate-us)) specifically provides information for the U.S. on the monthly comparisons with normal climate conditions.

Web sites of countries' National Meteorological Services may also have such data.

Some local gas and/or electric utilities maintain this information for their service areas.
